"Real change is possible if you're willing to start from the INSIDE OUT"

You don't have to pretend that you have it all together when you don't.

You don't have to pretend that your best relationship deeply satisfies when it doesn't.

You don't have to pretend that your struggle with sin is a thing of the past.

Only Christians have the capacity to never pretend. That's because real change is only possible when you face the realities of your internal life and let God mold you into a person who is free to be honest, courageous, and loving.

If you want a more vital union with God, a richer relationship with others, and a deeper sense of personal wholeness, this book will help you look inside yourself and discover how God works real, liberating change when you live from the inside out.

Dr. Larry Crabb is the founder and director of the Institute of Biblical Counseling. He earned his PhD in clinical psychology and directed the Master's program in biblical counseling at Grace Theological Seminary.
